**PROPOSITION 1:
Repairing Streets and Bridges**

Prop 1 helps us continue to move in the right direction! Safe access to major thoroughfares, historic Route 66, and new homes will pay dividends to our community for future generations. Enhancements to our downtown will make Sapulpa the best place to live, work, and play.

**PROPOSITION 2:
Public Safety Buildings**

Prop 2 will keep the community and our first responders safe. Replacing Fire Station 3 (40 years old) and constructing a fire training facility will result in tremendous insurance savings to all property owners. It also funds computer-aided dispatch tech, repairs to central police station and other facilities, and funds public safety vehicles needed to equip and support our first responders.

**PROPOSITION 3:
Park Improvements**

Prop 3 will improve our parks, trails, golf course and other facilities. Quality of life makes Sapulpa special, and enhancing these facilities provides activities our citizens enjoy. Facilities targeted for improvement benefit all ages in every part of our city by including ADA-accessible playgrounds, restrooms, and much more.

**PROPOSITION 4:
Economic Growth**

Prop 4 gives resources to offer incentives, purchase property and make arrangements to bring new businesses, restaurants, and industries to Sapulpa to stimulate growth and enhance our quality of life. These funds will only be expended upon community approval.

**PROPOSITION 5:
Booker T. Washington Rec Center**

Prop 5 will fund replacement of the Booker T. Washington Recreation Center to improve access and attract sports events, tournaments, and increase tourism in our city.

**PROPOSITION 6:
Sapulpa's Youth Sports Complex**

Prop 6 allows us to continue expansion of the Youth Sports Complex by providing lighted fields for baseball, soccer and football activities, with all necessary parking, restrooms, and road access.
